Quick Facts on Signage

Permitted Commercial Signage:

- Generally allowed a total of 250 square feet of signage for the site. This shall include main sign and any additional building mounted signs.
- Permanent Banners are limited 15 square feet and must be kept in good repair.
- Temporary signs and banners up to 32 square feet are to be limited to a use of 90 days and only once per year. (Permit required)
- No sign shall exceed 30 feet in mounting height
- All signs together with any supports, braces, guys, and anchors shall be kept in good repair and shall be constructed in compliance with applicable Building Code requirements.
- A Sign Permit is required for the installation of any sign exceeding 6 square feet in size. (All advertising signs regardless of size count toward 250 SF limit)

Prohibited Signs:

- Signs which incorporate in any manner any flashing, moving, or intermittent lighting. This does not include time and temperature units.
- Signs which by reason of their position, working, illumination, size, shape, or color may obstruct impair, obscure or interfere with the view of, or be confused with, any authorized traffic control sign, signal, or device.
- Signs which by reason of their position, size, or shape obstruct any sign previously erected.
- Signs for whatever purpose that are obscene, lewd, indecent, immoral, or lascivious.
- Signs that create a safety hazard by obstructing the view of pedestrian or vehicular traffic.
- Signs which are located all or partially on or over a street, alley, or public property other than sidewalks.
- Signs on public utility posts or poles, unless required by law or authorized by the city commission as a governmental usage.
- Portable signs.
