Chapter 7

FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION

Section 7.1 Fire prevention code adopted

- (a) For the purpose of providing for the protection of its citizens from the dangers of fire arising in connection with hazardous processes and materials, the City hereby adopts the current and prevailing edition of that certain code known as the *Standard Fire Prevention Code*, 1976 Edition, as prepared and published by the *Southern Building Code Congress International*, *Inc.*, of which one [1] copy has been and now is on file in the office of the City Manager.
- (b) Except as otherwise provided in this Chapter, and where not in conflict with the laws of the State pertaining thereto, all of the rules and regulations contained in the fire prevention code above mentioned are hereby incorporated as a part of this Code as fully as though each part, section, clause and phrase were set out herein at length. (Code 1958, § 10-5)
