

On July 9, 2020, the Crescent City Commission Adopted Resolution R20-06 Recommending the use of Face Coverings within the City limits to best address the interest of public health, safety, and general welfare consistent with the requirements of Section 166.021(4), Florida Statutes to address the continued spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) Global Pandemic.

## Through this resolution, the City Commission states the following:

- Implores every person working, living, visiting, or doing business in the City of Crescent City
  to wear a face covering in any indoor location, other than their home or residence, when not
  maintaining social distancing from other person(s), excluding family members or
  companions.
- 2. That nothing in this resolution requires or allows a person to wear a face covering to conceal the identity of the wearer in violation of Chapter 876, Florida Statutes.
- 3. Encourages all businesses to prohibit entry of any person who is not wearing a face covering with the following **exceptions**:
  - a. Children under the age of 2 years.
  - b. Observing social distancing in accordance with CDC guidelines.
  - c. Whom a face covering would cause impairment due to an existing health condition.
  - d. Working in a business or profession who do not have interactions with other persons.
  - e. Working in a business or profession who maintain social distancing from others.
  - f. Working in a business or profession where use of a face covering would prevent them from performing the duties of the business or profession.
  - g. Exercising, while maintaining social distancing.
  - h. Eating or drinking.
  - i. Public safety, fire, and other life safety and health care personnel, as their personal protective equipment requirements will be governed by their respective agencies.
  - j. Anyone who is hearing impaired needs to see the mouth of someone wearing a face covering to communicate.
  - k. Participating in an outdoor activity permitted under City, County, or State order, but face coverings should be readily available when coming within six (6) feet of an individual not part of a person's immediate family or cohabitating living unit.
  - I. Infants and children in day care centers that do not understand the need for social distancing or the wearing of face coverings.
  - m. All employees in any capacity in daycare centers shall wear face coverings at all times, unless one of the exceptions above may be applicable, i.e. eating or drinking, etc.

This Resolution becomes effective on **July 10, 2020**, **at 12:01 am** and shall remain in effect in the City of Crescent City for so long as Governor Ron DeSantis' Executive Order declaring a Public Health Emergency in the State of Florida is in effect or unless otherwise modified or repealed.
