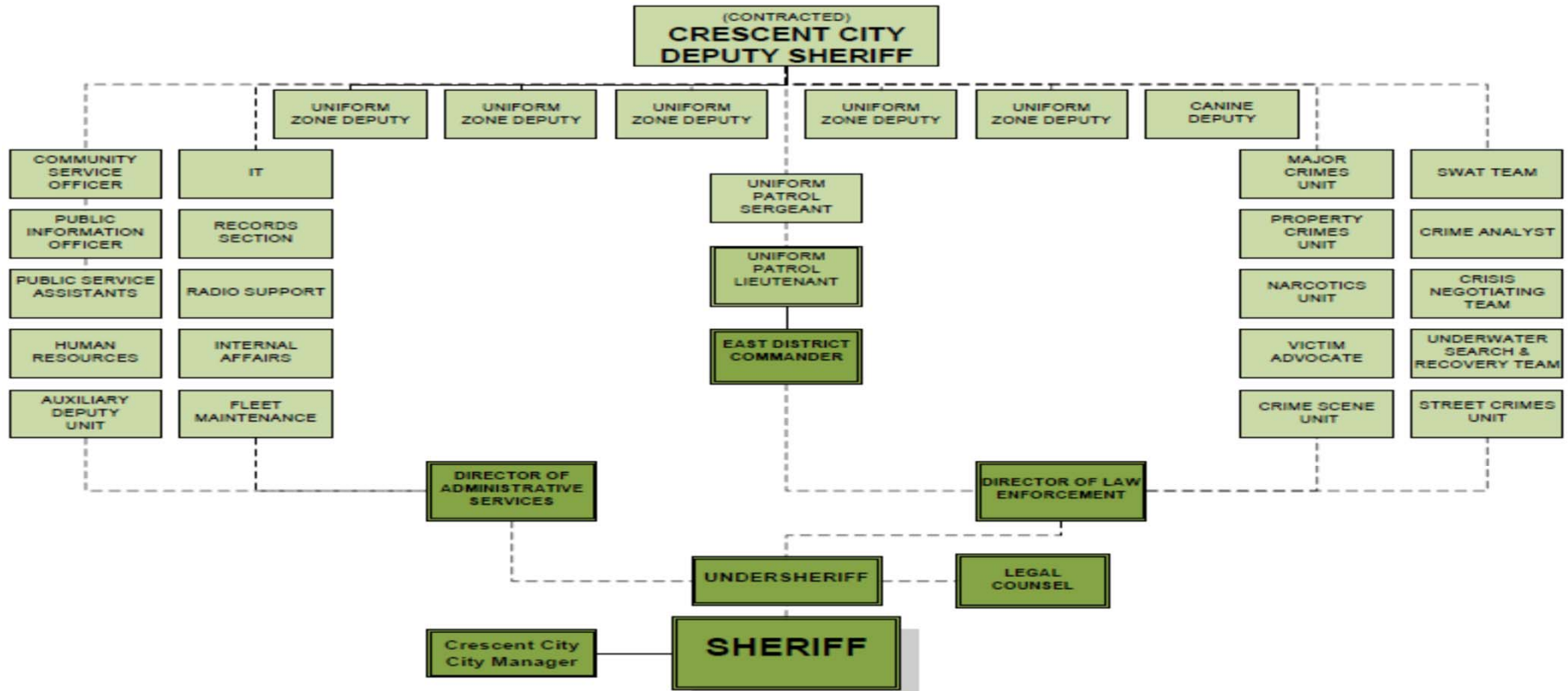

Maintaining Crescent City Identity



- Transform current police station into Sheriff's Sub-Station
- Maintain business hours staffing of sub-station with a clerk
- District Commander to maintain regular hours at sub station to be available to residents and city officials
- District Commander attendance at commission meetings to make presentations and address public concerns
- Special markings on patrol vehicles to identify them as Crescent City Deputies
- Same Deputy Sheriffs inside Crescent City for community familiarity





What do you stand to lose by partnering with the Sheriff?

- Lapses in law enforcement coverage
- Disabling lack of resources to conduct criminal investigations
- Significant distraction for city administration and government
- Absence of accountability and effective crime control strategies
- Lack of effective crime prevention and community engagement programs
- Insufficient training for officers in today's complex criminal justice setting
- Absence of comprehensive victim services
