



## **City of Crescent City – Public Notice on Water Quality and Construction Activity**

The City of Crescent City is aware of recent community discussions regarding water quality in the area surrounding the high school construction site. We want to reassure our residents that this situation is **isolated** and directly related to ongoing construction activities.

At this time, **no tests have returned positive for E. coli** contaminants. Out of an abundance of caution, the city is performing its routine water-quality testing earlier than scheduled and increasing the frequency of testing to ensure that all municipal water remains safe.

Based on current information, the **only area potentially affected is along Union Avenue from CR 308 to HWY 17**, specifically within the construction zone near the schools. There is **no evidence** of water-quality concerns anywhere else in the municipal water system.

Students and staff at the high school have been provided with and will continue to be provided with **bottled water, hand sanitizers, and appropriate cleaning supplies by the School District and the school contractor**. These measures were implemented solely as a precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone on campus.

All residents and business owners within the affected area on Union Avenue have been contacted directly.

The city remains committed to transparency, public safety, and clear communication. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and provide updates as necessary.
